MSCA Doctoral Networks

At institutional level:

- Consortium including at least three institutions, each established in a different EU Member States (MS) and Horizon Europe Associated Countries (AC) and with at least one of them established in a MS prepares a training programme of max. 4 years for PhD students
- Types of programmes:
 - Doctoral Networks
 - Industrial Doctorates
 - Joint Doctorates

At individual level:

- DN are open to Doctoral Candidates = not have been awarded a doctoral degree at the date of the recruitment
- PhD students have to be enrolled in a doctoral programme




MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships

- Individual research project: training-through-research under direct supervision
- Researchers who receive funding have to move from one country to another to acquire new knowledge, skills and competences (mobility rule)

Two types of fellowships:

- European Postdoctoral Fellowships: coming to Europe (MS/AC) from any country in the world or moving within Europe, 12-24 months
- Global Postdoctoral Fellowships: 24-36 months, outgoing phase (12-24 months, outside EU MS/AC) + mandatory return phase in Europe (12 months)



In possession of PhD at the call deadline

Up to **8 years research experience** after PhD (with exceptions: career breaks, work outside research, research outside Europe for reintegrating researchers,...)

Mobility rule: not resided / had main activity in the country of the beneficiary (or host organisation for GF) more than 12 months in the 36 months before call deadline



MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships

Typical Postdoctoral Fellowship

- Two way transfer of knowledge between researcher and host
- Hands on training: scientific skills (new techniques, instruments, etc.) and transferable skills (proposal preparation, patent applications, management of IPR, gender issues, Open Science, etc.)
- Dissemination and Communication activities
- Secondments can take place in MS / AC, up to 1/3 of project duration, additional period of up to 6 months in a non-academic organisation at the end of the project

Alternative funding

- ERA Fellowships (Horizon Europe)
 - In order to promote fellowships in the countries with low participation = Widening Countries, e.g. Czech Republic
 - When submitting your proposal to the Postdoctoral Fellowships Call, you can opt in for this type of grant, the evaluation is based on the evaluation of MSCA PF
- International Mobility of Researchers "MSCA PF CZ" (Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports)
 - Proposals which obtained a high score in the MSCA PF call but were not funded under that call



MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships: Evaluation and award criteria

Each criterion is scored out of 5, proposals scoring equal to or above 70% are considered for funding

MSCA Staff Exchanges

At institutional level:

Consortium of at least three institutions in three different countries, two of which in a MS/AC, prepares a collaborative research and innovation project of max. 4 years based on staff exchanges which are intersectoral (academia x non-academic sector), international (incl. third countries outside Europe) and interdisciplinary

At individual level:

 Any type of staff can carry out their secondments of 1-12 months (Doctoral Candidates, Postdoctoral Researchers, administrative, managerial and technical staff)





MSCA COFUND

European Commission supports financially national, regional, or international schemes for doctoral training and postdoctoral fellowships

- Doctoral Programmes
- Postdoctoral Programmes

At institutional level:

- These programmes can be managed by a regional authority, funding agency, university, research organisation, enterprise etc.
- EU contribution is limited to EUR 10 million per beneficiary per call
- Duration of projects: max. 5 years

At individual level:

- Doctoral Candidates/Postdoctoral Researchers of any nationality can submit their application if they fulfill selection criteria
- Fellowships: min. 3 months
- EURAXESS portal: <u>COFUND Programmes</u>





MSCA AND CITIZENS

- Bring research and researchers closer to the public at large, with a focus notably on families, pupils and students
- Through the organisation of the European Researchers' Night: Europewide public event, which displays the diversity of science and its impact on citizens' daily lives
- Every researcher can join this event!!!


