The project Adaption strategies organise the Project proposal seminar for project managers in forestry under global climate change impact (ASFORCLIC). ASFORCLIC has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under grant agreement N°952314. It will complete its project cycle in 36 months. The project was launched on 1 January 2021.

The ASFORCLIC focuses on the ambitious goals of raising the research profile and strengthening research excellence of the selected fields at the Mendel University in Brno, Czech Republic, in the highly demanding global climate change impact on the forest and whole bio-based sector.
